**RULES**

1. Entries in this department close July 15.
2. Entries must be made upon regulation entry forms, or online.
3. Each article entered must be the work of the exhibitor.
4. All entries cover the general field of Ceramics, whereby all pieces must be fired in a kiln.
- 5A. Articles with entry tags attached may be brought in Sunday, July 29, 10:00 to 1:00 and Monday, July 30, 9:00 to 11:00.
- 5B. Articles must be picked up Monday, August 6, 9:00 to Noon. You must have the claim check to pick your items up.
6. There will be a \$1.00 entry fee required per exhibit. Please send a self-addressed stamped (business size) envelope to receive your entry tags.
7. Exhibitors are limited to two entries in each class.
8. The management will use diligence to ensure the safety of articles after their arrival and placement, but in no case will they be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
9. All children's entries must be completed by the child, except for firing.
10. Please, no lampshades, plants and felt-on entries. Entire clay article must be visible for judging. Doll clothing must be able to be removed by judge.
11. If only one entry in a category and does not warrant a blue ribbon, a lesser ribbon could be given.
12. Any premium may be withheld at the discretion of the judge, whose decision shall be final.
13. Bottoms of pieces must be finished unless hand built or hand formed pottery, porcelain or dry footed.

**Professional - Any person who has taught or sold Ceramics will be classified as a Professional.**  
**Hobbyist - Those who do not sell their creations, except an occasional sale of art objects, or teach at any time.**
