RULES

1. This is an open show and anyone is eligible to enter an exhibit. There is a \$1.00 entry fee for each article.
 2. Entries will be judged on the basis or originality, use of tools, assembly technique, and workmanship. Each article will be judged on each phase of work applied to it.
 3. Two entries per class per person.
 4. Entries must be the sole work of the person entering, and must have been completed within 2 years (since August 1, 2016).
 5. Junior and Beginner Class Entries, write age on entry tag.
 6. Entry forms must be postmarked no later than July 15 to be accepted.
6A. Mail-in entries must be received not later than the Friday before judging, with entry tags attached and include return postage with entry form, shipping instructions and packing list.
6B. Walk-in entries accepted with entry tags attached not later than 11:00 A.M. on Monday, July 30.
 7. All entries must remain on exhibit until 9:00 P.M., Sunday, August 5.
 8. Exhibitors may pick up their entries on Monday, August 6 between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.
 9. The Fair Management will use diligence to ensure the safety of entries after their arrival but in no case can the Association be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
 10. Fill out entry form, return to Mississippi Valley Fair, 2815 W Locust St., Davenport, IA 52804. Please send stamped self-addressed envelope (business size) to receive your entry tags or enter online.
