**RULES**

1. Entries in this department close July 15. Entry fees: \$1.00 per exhibit.
2. Entries must be made on regulation entry blanks or online.  
Please send a self-addressed stamped (business size) envelope to receive your entry tags.
3. Articles with entry tags attached must be brought in from 10:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M., Sunday, July 29 and remain in place until Monday, August 6.
4. Pick up Monday August 6<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 A.M. till 12:00 noon. You must have the claim check. Any item not picked up will be taken to the Fair Office.
5. Children's Division: For ages 12 and under. Plastic, metal snap together, screw together, glue together, repainted or pre decorated kits are only permitted in the children division. No wood or Lego type kits are allowed. Exhibits in the children's division can be any scale, so long as the exhibit meets the case size requirements (see rule 8).
6. Teen Division. For ages 13 to 17. Plastic glue together kits only in this division. Teen class number 3 is limited to 1/24 and 1/25 scales. Teen class numbers 4 and 5 can be any scale as long as the exhibit meets case size requirements (see rule 8).
7. Adult Division. For ages 18 and older. Plastic glue together kits only in this division. Adult class number 6 is limited to 1/24 and 1/25 scales. Adult classes 4 and 5 can be any scale size, so long as the exhibit meets the case size requirements (see rule 8).
8. All exhibits, in any scale for all Divisions, must not exceed 12" in any directions.
9. Stands or Bases are only permitted in the children's division and the miscellaneous classes for both adult and teen divisions. They must meet rule 8 and be included in the original kit.
10. All exhibits are judged equally in respect to their divisions and classes. Models are judged on: (1) Craftsmanship and construction; (2) Originality and neatness.
11. Exhibitors may enter two entries per class, except Diorama this class can only have one entry per exhibitor.
12. Anyone may enter in nay class, except in such cases that they teach or sell their creations as a means of living.
13. Exhibits may not have been exhibited at the Mississippi Valley Fair.
14. Any premium may be withheld at the discretion of the judge, whose decision shall be final.
15. Space being limited, the Fair management reserves the right to screen entries to fit available facilities.
16. The management will use diligence to ensure the safety of articles in the show, but in no case will they be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.

9. Diorama-Farm Field Find. Same rules as plastic models still apply but also \*See special rules for Dioramas\*

Theme for the 2018 Mississippi Valley Fair is Farm Field Find. It is an abandoned car or small truck sitting in an old farmer's fields out in the back country of Iowa or Illinois

\*\*\*\*\* Special rules for Dioramas \*\*\*

1. Open to ages 13 and over. Limited to 4 entries only.
2. Dioramas base must be made of wood and sturdy. All diorama components, include the model, must be firmly secured to the base. No kit included bases or stands allowed.
3. Only one model is permitted per each Diorama, and must be a plastic glue together kit.
4. However, scenery and other diorama components may be made from any other materials as the modeler sees fit.
5. Must be child appropriate and suitable for public exhibition. Any exhibit deemed too explicit in any way by fair management will be disqualified from the competition.
6. Dioramas are judged equally in respect to the given theme. Judging criteria is as follows: (1) Construction of model, Components and Scenery (2) Presentation of theme and Settings (3) story line and mood.
7. Model must be 1/24 or 1/25 in scale.
8. No buildings are allowed. However, smaller details are permitted (such as fence or a small tree.)
9. The diorama may have up to two figures, but no more.
10. The theme as well as the rules for this class will change every year.
11. Exhibitors may enter one entry only in this class.
