- 2. ENTRIES: Entries close at midnight July 15. No entry will be accepted unless on official entry form and accompanied by all proper fees. The right is reserved to reject any entry offered. Entry fee \$10.00.
- 3. 4-H members wishing to enter in open class must pay open class entry fee.
- 4. OWNERSHIP. All animals entered and shown must be registered in their respective breed association and must be recorded in the exhibitor's name on the records in the home office of said association. Registration papers will be checked. Animals owned in partnership may be entered and shown only as the ownership is recorded on the books in the office of the respective breed associations.
- 5. No animal will be awarded a prize unless removed from its stall and exhibited in the show ring.
- 6. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS as set forth earlier in this book. Health papers will be checked by the official veterinarian.
- 7. Exhibitor may show only two in any single class. In group classes only one entry per exhibitor.
- 8. All fans and other electrical equipment used in the livestock barns must meet with the requirements of the City of Davenport's electrical safety code and stand inspection by their agents.
- 9. Trailers must park in designated area.
- 10. No painting hooves on cement floors.
