Class Fee - \$10 for non starred classes. *Late Entries accepted at \$15 per class until July 26, 2017. Entries accepted day of show at \$20.00 per class.

Entrants in * single-starred classes pay no entry fee if previously entered in minimum of one other class. ** Double-starred classes will not have entry fees.

\$10.00 Gate Admission (Day of Show) - Do not send with entry.

Stall/Grounds Fee \$10 per horse

Ribbons: 1st thru 5th - Champion & Reserve Ribbons

Measuring will begin at 11:00 A.M., Thursday, for those entries not possessing a current AMHR Measurement Card. ALL FOALS MUST BE MEASURED AND REGISTERED.

STALL & GROUNDS INFORMATION:

1. Stalls available after 10:00 A.M., Thursday, August 3, 2017.
2. Stalls and gates/panels will be available. Stalls are limited - plan on multiple horses per stall.
3. Recommend all horses be tied. Horses will be housed in the new building (Iowa Building), directly across from show arena.
4. Show will be held in the Claussen Building (Directly across from the stalling area). Show will start no sooner than 12:30 P.M. or at the completion of the Belgian Classes.
5. Sawdust or straw bedding only. Bring your own. NO WOOD CHIPS.

GENERAL SHOW RULES MINIATURE HORSE SHOW

1. This show will be run under the rules set forth in the current revision of the AMHR rulebook.
Because of small entries, classes will be moved right along -- Please be prepared and ready.
2. All persons are notified that any misconduct or disobedience to the judge or show officials, by any exhibitor, trainer, or parent shall be cause for disqualification. In such cases, all entry and stall fees shall be forfeited.
3. All horses not possessing a current (within 60 days) temporary or permanent measurement will be measured Thursday, preceding the show. ALL Foals must be measured.
4. **ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS (Except for measurement purposes).**
Another horse may be substituted.
5. No horse shall be entered, or allowed to show, unless the owner/exhibitor shows proof of registration and height verification to show officials. Please carefully read AMHR's current height rules.
6. Tack stalls available on limited basis, if not needed for horses.
7. AMHR now requires an Amateur card to show in such classes. Available from AMHR Office for \$5. Please list amateur # on the entry blank.

8. It is your responsibility to list, on the entry sheet, the correct person as “Exhibitor or Handler”. This is important so credit can be given to the right people for the year-end awards. It is also your own responsibility to keep track of points also needed in some cases at year’s end.
9. Entries must be postmarked by July 15, 2017 or late fees will be due. Monetary fees and a copy of REGISTRATION PAPERS, front and back, (unless pending) must ACCOMPANY ENTRIES. Entries received without payment, or without necessary health, Coggins (only out of state horses) or registrations copies will not be posed and will be subject to a late fee.
10. When signing the entry form, which MUST BE SIGNED in order to be accepted as an entry, you are stating that you will abide by the above rules and regulations.

SECTION 6 - HORSES AND MULES

All horses shall be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with individual animal.

Native Iowa horses and mules can be exhibited when accompanied by an individual Certificate of Veterinary Inspection listing a description of the individual animals.

All equine originating from outside the state shall be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection listing a description of the individual animals; and indicating that each animal six months of age and older in the shipment has had a negative official equine infectious anemia test within twelve months of importation. The testing laboratory, accession date and date of test must appear on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

THE VETERINARY INSPECTOR IN CHARGE SHALL ORDER ANY ANIMALS, POULTRY OR BIRDS, WHEN FOUND TO BE INFECTED WITH ANY CONTAGIOUS OR INFECTIOUS DISEASES, TO BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIR OR EXHIBITION.
