RULES

1. Entries close July 15.
2. Animals may enter after 12:00 noon, Friday, August 3rd and must be in place by 8:00 a.m., August 4th, and will be released at 10:00 p.m. or after the show, whichever is earlier. Animals must be removed by 8:00 a.m., Sunday, August 6th.
3. Age of animals will be determined as of August 4th, the day of the show.
4. There will be no Pre-Show Milkout.
5. Judging will begin at approximately 11:00 a.m., Saturday, August 4th with the 4-H Show, followed by open showmanship. The milking does will show first, followed by junior does, then Group Classes. The show order will not change.
6. The order of show will be, Nubians, all other Purebreds, Recorded Grades, Saanen, Alpines, LaManchas, and Nigerian Dwarfs.
7. All animals shown in group classes must be shown in individual classes. Exhibitors limited to one entry per group class.
8. All group classes (except Jr. & Sr. Get of Sire) must include one doe in milk. NOTE: Jr. Get must all be dry, and Sr. Get must all be in milk.
9. The original registration certificate is required for all animals 6 months of age or older. All animals under 6 months of age may be shown with a stamped duplicate registration application.
10. All animals must have a general health certificate dated to within 30 days of show and are subject to rejection for unhealthy conditions at the discretion of the show committee and the Fair's Official Veterinarian.
11. All exhibitors are requested to be in white clothing when showing their animals.
12. Entry fees \$10.00 pen fee, plus \$2.00 per head if postmarked before the entry deadline. (3 small animals per pen). Tack pens are the same price: \$10.00 each.
13. Late Entry Fee \$5.00 per animal plus \$10.00 pen fee (postmarked after the official deadline, see rule 1).
14. This show is sponsored by the Mississippi Valley Fair and sanctioned through ADGA. ADGA rules shall govern. The Junior and Senior shows are separately sanctioned.
15. A youth show will be held. All youth between Kindergarten and 12th grade who participated in the open show and 4-H students are eligible to participate. Enter on day of show at 8am.
