NOTE: All ponies subject to measurement. Ponies must be 56" and under. Classes may be split or combined at management discretion. Proof of age of rider if questioned. Horse & Handler age determined as of Jan. 1, 2018. Youth must wear helmets, unless parent or guardian sign waiver. Appropriate attire required in all classes. May wear T-shirts or collared shirts in gaming classes. **NO TANK TOPS OR SPAGHETTI STRAPS.** Judge may permit short sleeve shirts if heat is an issue. Mississippi Valley Fair and/or Quad City All Breed Horse Association (QCABHA) is not responsible for loss, theft, or accidents of any kind. No horses allowed past horse arena or parking area designated for horse trailers.

8. Walk/Whoa Equitation (Rider 9 & under, horse or pony, headers allowed- **NO STALLIONS** (only eligible for class 8 & 11)
9. PeeWee Western Walk/trot (10 years & under- horse or pony)
10. Local Pony Pleasure- Pony/Rider must live within 50 miles of MVF (W/T/C) (\$50 added money by The Horse Lady- Gail Stevens)
