Mississippi Valley Fair Queen Scholarship Contest 2023 Rules

- Each contestant must be at least 16 years of age and not more than 21 years of age on August 10, 2023.
- Contestants must never have been married or have had children.
- Queen contestants must reside in Scott County or an adjoining county, if the majority of her activities are conducted in Scott County.
- Each contestant must be a member of at least one service organization in her community such as a Church group, Girl Scouts, 4-H, FFA, etc. (Eligibility is not limited to 4-H membership).
- The winner of the Mississippi Valley Fair Queen contest will rain during the MVF August 1-6, 2023 and assist with various activities during the week.
- The winner of the Mississippi Valley Fair Queen contest will represent Scott County and the Mississippi Valley Fair at the 2023 Iowa State Fair Competition August 8-12, 2023.
- No professional model (one who has had ongoing employment in which modeling was the primary part of the job) is eligible to compete.
- The new Queen will receive a sash and Crown and receive a \$1000 scholarship sponsored by the Mississippi Valley Fair.
- Judging for the contest will be based on the following:
 - o Personality, Attitude, Appearance and Awareness
 - o Leadership and Citizenship Contribution to Community
 - o Overall Appearance, Charm, Poise
- Each contestant should be prepared to appear in Street dress or suit, and casual wear.
- The reigning Mississippi Valley Fair Queen is expected to conduct herself in a manner that reflects positively on herself, her family, and on the Mississippi Valley Fair. should the reigning Mississippi Valley Fair Queen become involved in any activity, including a drug, alcohol, or tobacco related offense that reflects negatively on herself, her family, or the Mississippi Valley Fair, she may be required to forfeit her crown, title, and rights to the scholarship award to the first runner up.
