

## DIVISION 1-7 BREEDING BEEF CATTLE

**\*Entries close Tuesday July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026. \***

**Entries must be in the fair office before 5:00 P. M. or made online before midnight.**

**No late entries will be accepted.**

- **Entry Fee:** \$10.00 per class includes 1 stall. \$10.00 Tack stall (if available). Exhibitors may show only two in any single class.
- **Arrival:** Animals enter Fair Center from 3:00 - 9:00 P.M. Monday, August 3rd. Must be checked in by 10:00 a.m. Tuesday, August 4<sup>th</sup>.
- **Judging:** Tuesday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2:00 p.m. (or later, after the completion of the Dairy show).
- **Release:** Animals released immediately after the show. Must be out by 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday.

Class 8-13: 1<sup>st</sup> \$30.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$25.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$20.00. Ribbons Awarded 1<sup>st</sup> -5<sup>th</sup>.

### RULES

1. **IMPORTANT:** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to read and abide by the General Rules, Regulations, Health Requirements and IAFE Code of Ethics.
2. All entries must be made upon entry forms provided or online. If not entered online, complete entry form and return it with full payment of all fees.
3. **No painting hooves allowed in barns or on concrete, violation of this rule will result in disqualification and exhibitor will pay for any damages because of paint on concrete. No grooming chutes in the building.**
4. Scott County 4-H and FFA members can enter in open class day of show.
5. **OWNERSHIP:** All animals entered and shown must be registered in their respective breed association and must be recorded in the exhibitor's name on the records in the home office of said association. Registration papers will be checked. Animals owned in partnership may be entered and shown only as the ownership is recorded in the books in the office of the respective breed associations.
6. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Health papers will be checked by the official veterinarian. Must have health paper.
7. Trailers must park in the designated area.
8. Exhibitors must keep their cattle and stalls clean and presentable; manure and litter must be put in the appropriate place.

5. Junior Yearling Females calved between January 1, 2024, and March 31, 2025.
6. Senior Yearling Females calved between September 1, 2024, and December 31, 2024.
7. Cow/Calf

Reserve Grand Champion Female- (Remaining class winners, & the second-place winner from the class producing the Champion)
8. Junior Bull Calves calved after January 1, 2026.
9. Senior Bull Calves calved between October 1, 2025, and December 31, 2025.
10. Summer Yearling Bull calved between July 1, 2025, and September 30, 2025.
11. Spring Yearling Bull calved between April 1, 2025, and June 30, 2025.
12. Junior Yearling Bull calved between January 1, 2025, and March 31, 2025.
13. Senior Yearling and Two-Year-Old Bulls calved between January 1, 2024, and December 31, 2024.

1. Children 9 and under. No entry fees. Enter on the day of the show or online.
2. Calves born in the current year. Any beef breeds.
3. Calf may be entered and released on same day.
4. Calf must have a health certificate from an official veterinarian.
5. Awards based on showmanship.
