**RULES**

2. **IMPORTANT:** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to read and abide by the General Rules, Regulations, Health Requirements and IAFE Code of Ethics.
3. All entries must be made upon entry forms provided or online. If not entered online, complete entry form and return it with full payment of all fees.
4. **No painting hooves allowed in barns or on concrete, violation of this rule will result in disqualification and exhibitors will pay for any damages in result of painting on concrete.**
5. The age of animals will be determined as of August 4, the day of the show.
6. All animals must have a general health certificate dated to within 30 days of show and are subject to rejection for unhealthy conditions at the discretion of the show committee and the Fair's Official Veterinarian.
7. All exhibitors are requested to be in white clothing when showing their animals.
8. Classes available to K-12 students from Scott, Muscatine, Cedar & Clinton counties in Iowa and Rock Island County in Illinois
9. 4H and FFA members are also eligible to participate. Scott county 4H & FFA this is considered your county show. Please register with your county Extension office.
10. Exhibitors must keep their animals and stalls clean and presentable; manure and litter must be put in the appropriate place.
11. Grades & Registered animals will all show together.
12. Show order: Showmanship, Wethers, Females.
