Entries must be in the fair office before 5:00 P. M. or made online before midnight.
No late entries will be accepted.

- **Entry Fee:** \$20.00 per head for barrows and gilts in the Market Hog Division. If you enter an animal and want to switch animals, the identification of the animal may be changed at weigh in.
- **Arrival:** Fair Center-Market Hog Show weigh in, arrive Sunday, August 9, 8:30 - 10:30 A.M. **All swine will be vet checked on trailer prior to unloading in designated area.** must have health papers dated (within) 7 days prior to show date in hand. No showing off trailer.
- **Judging**-Sunday, August 9, 1:30 PM
- **Release:** Depart at completion of live judging same day for any variance in this schedule must be approved by the Department Superintendent.

RULES

1. **IMPORTANT:** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to read and abide by the General Rules and Regulations, Health Requirements – See Section 4 and IAFE Code of Ethics.
2. All entries must pre-register by entry forms provided or online. If not entered online, complete entry form and return it with full payment of all fees.
3. All hazards that are related to ownership and animals are the property of the exhibitor.
4. Exhibitors must drive their hogs in the show ring.
5. No maximum entry.
6. All producers are required to have a premise ID number and Health papers.
7. Entries open to Purebred and Crossbred Gilts and Barrows, and Gilt weighing a minimum of 230 pounds, with no maximum weight. Hogs are recommended to be in a normal market weight range. Animals enrolled in any Supervised Youth Project are eligible to compete in this division.
8. All hogs are the responsibility of the exhibitor. No individual pens will be assigned but holding pens will be provided.
9. All Purebred Breeds will show together.
10. Exhibitors must take hogs back to their origin after the show.
11. Exhibitors must keep their animals and stalls clean and presentable; manure and litter must be put in the appropriate place.
12. Scott county 4H and FFA exhibitors can enter the day of show.
