Entries close Tuesday July 28, 2026.

Entries must be in the fair office before 5:00 P. M. or made online before midnight.

No late entries will be accepted.

- **Entry Fee:** \$1.00 per entry. **Exhibitors may have only one entry in each class.**
- **Drop off:** Exhibits with entry tags attached must be brought to the Starlite Ballroom on Sunday, August 2, from 8:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.
- **Judging:** Sunday August 2 Starting at 2:00pm
- **Pick up:** Exhibits must be picked up with a claim ticket on Monday, August 10, 7:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M.

Premiums Awarded by Mississippi Valley Fair

- **Premiums Paid:** 1st \$10.00, 2nd \$7.00, 3rd \$6.00, 4th \$5.00.

Ribbons are awarded 1st through 5th in each class. Participation ribbons classes 1-21. Best of Show each Division: Rosette.

RULES

1. **IMPORTANT:** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to read and abide by the General Rules and Regulations.
2. All entries must be made on entry forms or online. If entering online entry tags may be printed by the exhibitor. If not, enter an online complete entry form and return it with full payment of all fees. To receive your entry tags please send a self-addressed stamped envelope with the entry.
3. **All entries must have an entry tag securely attached to the item by a string.**
4. In Preschool Class, it is required to state on the entry tag the percentage of adult help given to complete the project.
5. Exhibits may NOT have been exhibited at the Mississippi Valley Fair previously.
6. Exhibits are not to exceed 12" in any direction unless it can be folded to 12". **(See each class for exceptions)**
7. Entries will be judged equally on -- (1) Craftsmanship; (2) Structural and Decorative design; (3) Originality and neatness.
8. **If there are any special notations about your exhibit that you would like the judge to know, attach a 3" x 5" card with the information.**
9. You may enter in a class of a higher age bracket but not a lower age bracket.
10. Superintendents have the right to disqualify any entry if any of the entry rules or size requirements are not met or followed.
