- **Judging:** Monday, August 3 at 11:00 A.M.
- **Pick up:** Exhibits must be picked up with claim ticket Monday, August 10 from 7:00 A.M. -11:00 A.M.

## **RULES**

1. **IMPORTANT:** It is the exhibitor's responsibility to read and abide by the General Rules and Regulations.
2. All entries must be made upon entry forms provided or online. If entering online entry tags may be printed by exhibitor. If not entering online complete entry form and return it with full payment of all fees. To receive your entry tags please send a self-addressed stamped envelope with the entry.
3. Entries will be judged on the basis of originality, use of tools, assembly technique, and workmanship. Each article will be judged on each phase of work applied to it.
4. Entries must be the sole work of the person entering and must have been completed within 2 years (since August 1, 2024).
5. Demonstrations daily at the exhibit area.
